Joining Instructions

Using your telephone (landline or mobile) dial:

0333 0164 757

See if you can put your phone on ‘speaker’ or ‘hands free’ so that you can move it away from your ear. This isn’t essential but it might make it easier for you!

You will hear a woman’s voice saying “Welcome to Whypay (*and a short marketing message*)” then “Please enter your conference room number, followed by the hash key.” So, using your telephone keypad, type in:

69358527# (this is the Room Number)

You will then hear the same voice say “Please enter your Guest Pin, followed by the hash key.” So, using your keypad, type in:

1734# (this is the Guest Pin)

When you are connected, if you are first on the line some music will play. When someone arrives, you will hear a tone – just say hello, and when everyone is there we will begin.

and formed us in your own image.

Through him you have freed us from the slavery of sin,
giving him to be born of a woman and to die upon the
cross; you raised him from the dead
and exalted him to your right hand on high.

Through him you have sent upon us your holy and life-
giving Spirit,
and made us a people for your own possession.

Therefore with angels and archangels,
and with all the company of heaven,
we proclaim your great and glorious name,
for ever praising you and *saying*:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,
heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in
the highest.**

Accept our praises, heavenly Father,
through your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ,
and as we follow his example and obey his command,
grant that by the power of your Holy Spirit
these gifts of bread and wine
may be to us his body and his blood;
who, in the same night that he was betrayed,
took bread and gave you thanks;
he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying:
Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you;
do this in remembrance of me.
In the same way, after supper
he took the cup and gave you thanks;
he gave it to them, saying:
Drink this, all of you;
this is my blood of the new covenant,
which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of
sins.
Do this, as often as you drink it,
in remembrance of me.
Therefore, heavenly Father,
we remember his offering of himself
made once for all upon the cross;
we proclaim his mighty resurrection and glorious
ascension;
we look for the coming of your kingdom,
and with this bread and this cup
we make the memorial of Christ your Son our Lord.

Accept through him, our great high priest,
this our sacrifice of thanks and praise,
and as we eat and drink these holy gifts
in the presence of your divine majesty,
